Ordinary 11 – The Presence of God

This period in the liturgical year is called Ordinary Time, not because it is uneventful but because there are no significant feasts of the Lord. In a sense it is like most of life, average and somewhat routine. However, this does not mean that it is devoid of theological significance. The readings of today demonstrate this. Like much of life, they all deal with common themes: a tree, personal maturity, human life, a modest seed. Also like much of life, these simple, everyday realities abound with religious relevance. The readings today remind us that poetic imagery is an apt way of describing the mysterious presence of God in our midst; that this mystery unfolds by degrees like the gradual process of growth; that we need faith to understand the parabolic.

Our readings use the metaphor of the cedar beginning as a seedling. It took years to grow into the magnificent tree that it is. The same is true of the mustard seed. It is not an overnight phenomenon. It requires time to develop the trunk and branches that make up this remarkable plant. The development of moral integrity in a human being is just as gradual. Rooted in God, it flourishes in God's presence and produces fruit even into old age. So it is with the reign of God. It begins in very ordinary circumstances, and it matures gradually until it has spread itself far and wide.

Although the mystery of the reign of God unfolds within human history, we need eyes of faith to recognize it. Like the cedar and the mustard seed, it grows within the concreteness of human experience. Just as the life force that thrusts the branches farther and farther out cannot itself be seen, so the reign of God is mysterious, even incomprehensible. Still, it is there, inviting us, urging us to move forward, transforming our world.

St Ignatius Parish invites children in Year 3 or above, who belong to St Ignatius Parish and who have been Baptised, to enrol in the **SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION**.

Enrolments are invited for children who wish to complete their initiation into the Catholic Faith Community.

The SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION, will be held on Wednesday 4 September at 7.30pm at St Ignatius Church, Toowong.

Children who make their Sacrament of Confirmation this year will progress to making their Sacrament of First Eucharist in post-Easter Season 2025 and the Sacrament of First Penance during Lent in 2026, thereby completing their Sacraments of Initiation.

PPC Announcements – June 2024.

Formation. The PPC is proceeding with the implementation of recommendations from the Parish survey in 2023 and the Planning Workshop held in April. The priority is Faith Formation as the Parish moves to adopt the principles of synodality.


Eight Monday nights from 12 August to 30 September 2024, 7pm – 8:30pm, online via Zoom.
