15th Sunday – "Mission of the Church"

Pope Francis affirms that the Church's true mission is not to develop an efficient aid mechanism, modelled after an NGO. The profile of an apostle – who in simplicity and poverty proclaims the gospel with the one true power that comes from God – is recognized instead in the plain words that Jesus recommends to the disciples returning with joy from their mission: "we are unworthy servants." He reaffirms that the true mission of the church is "healing the wounds of the heart, opening doors, forgiving all, liberating, and saying that God is good, forgives all, is Father; God is gentle and always waits for us."

We hear today that Jesus called his disciples and sent them to take the gospel; it is he who calls. In the vocation of the disciple, the Lord gives power: the power to cast out impure spirits, to liberate, to heal. This is the power that Jesus gives. Jesus gives this power with plain advice: go into the community, but do not take anything for the journey except a staff, no bread, no bag, no money... in poverty.

The gospel, Pope Francis says, is so very rich and so powerful that it does not need to create large firms, big companies, in order to be proclaimed. It is true, we do get help and create aid organizations, for the Lord gives us gifts for this. But we must not forget the real mission behind this. We must not forget about poverty, forget our apostolic zeal and put our hope only in these means or the church will lapse into an NGO and become a fine organization: powerful but not evangelical, because the spirit will be lacking. We need to maintain our simple power of humble witness in poverty.

On their return Jesus brings the disciples away for some rest by themselves. He is not going to prepare them for the next stage in strategic planning (as we might do in business), but so that they can reflect on being a disciple. In this moment, Pope Francis asks: What would be the greatest praise for an apostle? The answer: "He was a labourer for the kingdom, he was a worker for the kingdom." It is to be someone whom the spirit works through in this world. Go and be this apostle in the world today.
