

This Sunday we will celebrate at all Parish Masses the Feast Day of St Ignatius of Loyola (which falls on Wednesday 31 July 2024) and also marks 108 years of our Parish.

John Chapter 6 (part 1)

The gospels for the next five weeks are taken from John 6, which centres on his Eucharistic theology. Over these weeks, I will develop some ideas on the symbols we use in our Eucharist.

Symbols are used for those things beyond words – to say what we cannot say, to see what we cannot see. The raising of the flag on ANZAC day is a rich symbol. The Aussie flag itself symbolizes Aussies everywhere and always – most especially when we are away from Australia.

Football is also very symbolic. If you were able to get the ball from a winning Grand Final, surely you would take it home and put it in a 'sacred place' – in the Church the sacred place is the 'tabernacle'. But football is more than the ball; it is also the whole game. In a similar way, Eucharist is the bread and wine, but it is also the whole celebration.

Through symbols we move from what we see and say, into deeper mystery, we move into a different reality of things. Mystery is not that which cannot be known, but that which cannot be fully explained. Therefore, one experience is never enough for symbols, for mystery, we must experience it again and again. So a football supporter does not watch his team only once in his life, but compelled to watch them again and again. So too with the Eucharist, we need to come to recognize Christ in the breaking of the bread. And we must return to this again and again to plumb the depths of the mystery revealed in this rich symbol of God's presence within each one of us.

Next week I will reflect on the meaning of Sacrament, and on the symbol of 'bread' in the Eucharist.


