

St Ignatius Parish invites children in Year 3 or above, who belong to St Ignatius Parish and who have been Baptised, to enrol in the SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION.

Enrolments are invited for children who wish to complete their initiation into the Catholic Faith Community.

RITE OF ENROLMENT will be held on Sunday 21 July 2024 at Parish Masses.

PREPARATION SESSIONS

will be held on Sundays 21 & 28 July, 4, 11, 17 & 25 August, following 8.00 am Mass at Holy Spirit Church, Auchenflower, from 9.15—10.15am, OR

following 8:30am Mass at Holy Family Church, Indooroopilly from 10:45–11:45am.

There is an expectation that parents and children will attend Mass every Sunday in our Parish Community and all six preparation sessions.

The **SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION**, will be held on Wednesday 4 September at 7.30pm at St Ignatius Church, Toowong.

Children who make their SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION this year will progress to making their SACRAMENT OF FIRST EUCHARIST in post-Easter Season 2025 and the Sacrament of First Penance during Lent in 2026, thereby completing their Sacraments of Initiation.


