We give thanks for the deep and enduring legacy of these ancient peoples and their contributions to our Continent.

Let us also take a moment to recognise and appreciate the land on which our Parish is situated and the people who have nurtured it over time.

Together, let us continue to cultivate a spirit of unity and respect for all cultures and traditions within our community.

In the wake of last year's referendum result, the theme this year is 'Keep the Fire Burning: Strong in Faith'. It's worth noting that Brisbane is the diocese with the largest number of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Catholics – 16,474 at the last census.

thereby completing their Sacraments of Initiation.

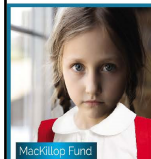

been under the same roof for a few months.

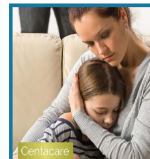

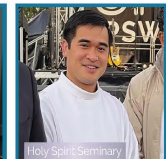

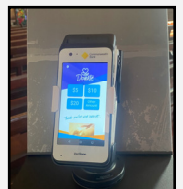
The devices are positioned at church doors at weekend Masses, to receive your electronic donations.

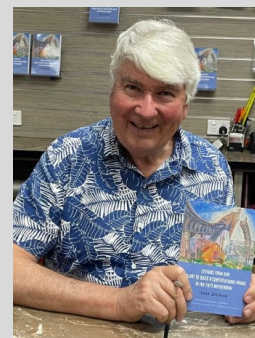

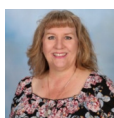
