John 6 (part II)

Last week I wrote about symbols, this week it is about the symbol of bread we use in the sacrament of Eucharist.

Firstly, it is important to define what we mean by sacrament. A "sacrament" is a visible sign, in word or action, of the presence of God in the world. Sacraments have a language of their own; we must understand how our sacramental symbols (bread, wine, oil, hands, etc.) are used in daily life. We must contemplate how these things are used in daily life, so that we know how to use them properly in the liturgy.

BREAD – this is the most basic element of our food culture, our staple food. Food and life go together - if we do not eat then we die. Bread becomes us, "we are what we eat". We work to put food on the table, food restores our energy for work. Every loaf of bread is a gift of the whole of creation – it requires sun and water, planting and harvesting, processing into flour and cooked into bread.

In the Old Testament, food is a sign of God's care. When we invite someone to share a meal, we are offering to give them life, to share God's care of them. When we gather around the table, we are acknowledging the importance of the other. (It is a tragedy that some families today do not gather around a table anymore!)

When Jesus says; "I am the bread of life" – this, therefore, has real deep meaning for us. Jesus is present, in a real sacramental way, in the sharing of this bread of Eucharist, and in the sharing of all the 'bread' that sustains life.

Next week I will look at how wine compliments our symbol of bread.





To use, it is as simple as:

1. Choose the amount you would like to give, by touching the device screen (on \$5, \$10, \$20 or 'other amount'),

2. Then tap your credit card or smart phone over the device (as you would for any other electronic purchase). If you require any assistance with using the device, please speak to the Sacristan (at the Mass you are attending).
