# Who Is Jesus ?

We come finally to the heart of the Gospel of Mark – who is Jesus? As readers we have known this from the start, but not so the disciples or others; they had all made the standard guesses as to his identity. But those closest to Jesus, who have had the privilege of Jesus explaining his teachings and were witness to his whole journey, are the ones who begin to understand that Jesus is the Messiah. However, Jesus does not want this proclaimed, because he does not fulfil their expectations of what the Messiah is to be: not one who will be served and honoured, as is customary in the case of rulers of this world, but rather one who is "to serve and give his life as a ransom for many" (10:45).

For the rest of the Gospel the disciples will wrestle – quite unsuccessfully as it turns out – with these two truths about Jesus: that he is the long-awaited Messiah and that he will fulfil his messianic role by entering into the pain of the world, even to the point of death – something totally unforeseen in Jewish messianic expectation. Peter's remonstrance with Jesus voices just such an incompatibility between the two.

The fact that Peter who has just got something so splendidly right stumbles so badly at the thought of suffering is, nonetheless, an encouragement – a recognition in the gospels that as far as suffering is concerned, we all do badly; each new cross that presents itself places us before the great dilemma of this scene anew. How then do I wrestle with an understanding of the all-powerful Messiah and a suffering God?
