Ordinary Sunday 26— “They are not one of us!”

“They are not one of us!” is an exclusive catch-cry that can be raised in many social, political and religious arenas. Consider these: migrants will take our jobs, asylum seekers will threaten our security, community housing or disability services will lower our house prices, or contact with other religions will dilute our faith.

In our gospel today we hear exclusion coming from the Twelve. John (spokesman this time) is alerting Jesus to a man “who is not following us” yet is “exorcising in your name.” And John wants Jesus to do something about this. But Jesus wants the disciples to see such a person, not as a competitor, but as a companion.

The incident in Numbers is also about inclusion and exclusion. Joshua is a stickler for details; Eldad and Medad seem to be flaunting the authority of Moses because they were not at the tent with the others – why should they share in the authority like the others? Joshua is not ready to allow for the surprising action of God’s spirit outside the established structures. Moses, however, welcomes and encourages the work of God’s spirit wherever and however it is manifest. The Spirit is not exclusively possessed and controlled by the community’s leaders (as much as we would like it to be sometimes!).



Now that we know that this is how God acts – in the Old and New Testament – it should not surprise us when God continues to act like this today. God continues to speak through those outside the hierarchy, even outside the Church! (One of my Jesuit formators once said that Michael Leunig is one of Australia’s best theologians!)

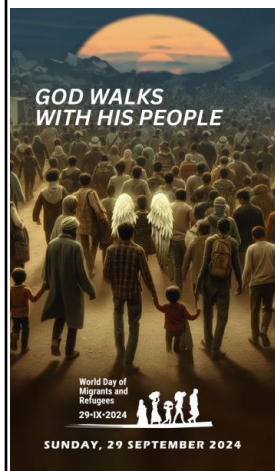
110th World Day of Migrants and Refugees – Sunday 29 September 2024.

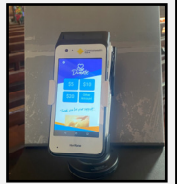

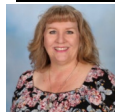
