The Rich Young Man

Jesus likes this young man, in fact, the gospel relates that "Jesus, looking at him, loved him..." And because he loved him, Jesus wanted the best for him, even if that was going to be something hard. If you do not care, then you can let them jump into the lake. But you do care. You love them enough to care, and therefore you make demands. Jesus loves him too much to let him settle for just being "a good man". Jesus is saying: "You can do better than this!"

Jesus is speaking to us today too. Maybe even more than the rich young man, we are caught in a possessive and consumerist culture. We trade in our phones and computers every few years for the latest model. We want the latest dishwasher or coffee machine to make our lives a little better and easier. The pressure of advertising is on us to keep up appearances, to maintain my status, to have what everyone else has, to accumulate what everyone else accumulates, to increase my social profile, fill our houses, making it necessary to rent our mini-warehouses to contain our excesses. So we, good people, rationalize and not ever suspects that Jesus is looking at us with love, saying we can do better than this, that we are not everybody else. Jesus is asking us to let go of many things for the sake of greater love, growth, and witness to the gospel.

Recent gambling advertisements carry with them mandatory taglines such as "Imagine what you could be buying instead?" Our gospel today might challenge us to give more of our wealth away – tithing is an ancient spiritual remedy for selfishness and loss of Christian identity. Tithing should be built into our lifestyle.

Jesus looks on us with love, but it is not the gushy love of greeting cards or insipid hymns. It is a tough love that reminds us that, good people that we are, we can do better, must do better. Don't walk away sad. Accept the gospel challenge.
